From the Pastor

LOOKING AHEAD: WHAT TO EXPECT AT WORSHIP THIS SUMMER

Summertime worship can offer a unique opportunity to focus our hearts and minds on a specific topic or series of topics. One of the things that was suggested to me for this summer is taking a leisurely yet purposeful walk through the way we worship and why we do the things we do. Let's face it, Lutheran worship is far different from the way many other Christians worship. Some have wondered why we don't do things in worship more like this or that denomination does things. At the same time, there are voices around us that suggest that the liturgy, or not having a liturgy, and the kinds of hymns that are sung don't really matter. Christian freedom says we can do things however we see fit.

While Christian freedom certainly plays a role in how we worship, we can't say that how we do things doesn't matter. There are reasons why we worship the way we do, and it goes far beyond tradition. So if you've ever wondered why we do what we do in worship, your questions will generally be answered in our summer sermon series: "Come, Let Us Worship the Lord!" You'll see that there are good and important reasons why we have the following elements in our worship service, and what the meaning is not just for our 1-hour worship service but how it is a pattern of our daily walk with Christ:

- The Invocation: Calling on the Name of the Lord – Proverbs 18:10
- The Hymns: Sing to the Lord a New Song! – Psalm 98
- The Sacrament of Holy Baptism: The New Life Begins – John 3:3-18
- The Confession and Absolution: A pattern for Christian Living – 1 John 1:5-2:2
- The Kyrie: Lord, Have Mercy on My Life! – Romans 9:16
- The Prayers: Participating in the Will of God – 2 Kings 20:1-11
- The Word: Feeding on the Bread of Life – Colossians 3:16
- The Offering: Giving from the Heart – 2 Corinthians 9:1-15
- The Sacrament of the Altar: Remembrance, Reception, Restoration, Reunion – Matthew, Mark, Luke and the Apostle Paul
- The Thanksgiving: Give Thanks to the Lord, for He Is Good! – Psalm 107
- The Blessing: In Us, Over Us, Through Us – Numbers 6:22-27

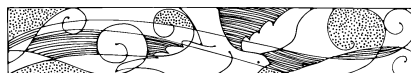
COOKBOOK DEADLINE
