### PARENT TRANSPORT/BRING OWN LUNCH DAY

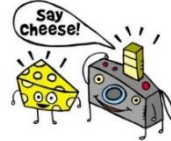
There will be **NO** parent transport/bring your own lunch this month. \*There will, however, be two days in October.
