VOLLEYBALL

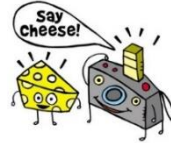
Volleyball continues into the month of October. Please take note that there is still help that is needed to run our annual volleyball tournament at Wonewoc-Center.
