We had a few days where we were dismissing students at 3:00pm. Due to the Snow/Cold days, we will be dismissing at 3:15pm

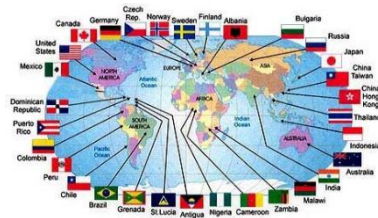
everyday until the end of the semester.
