SPRING ROUND-UP

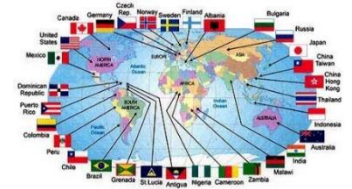
